Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

South Creake (WTRO6132) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to stop tap replacement works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the B1355 Burnham Road from 200m south of its junction with U22185 Back Street for 50m southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of South Creake will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Fakenham Road, The Common, Burnham Market Road, Creake Road, Lynn Road, Tattersett Road, Syderstone Road, Docking Road, Bircham Road, Burnham Road, Stanhoe Road, North Street, Church Street (Tattersett, Dunton, East Rudham, Burnham Thorpe, Barwick, Stanhoe, Burnham Market, Sculthorpe, Bagthorpe with Barmer, Barsham, Docking, North Creake, South Creake, Syderstone).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 15th to 21st August 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 4th September 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 4th September 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

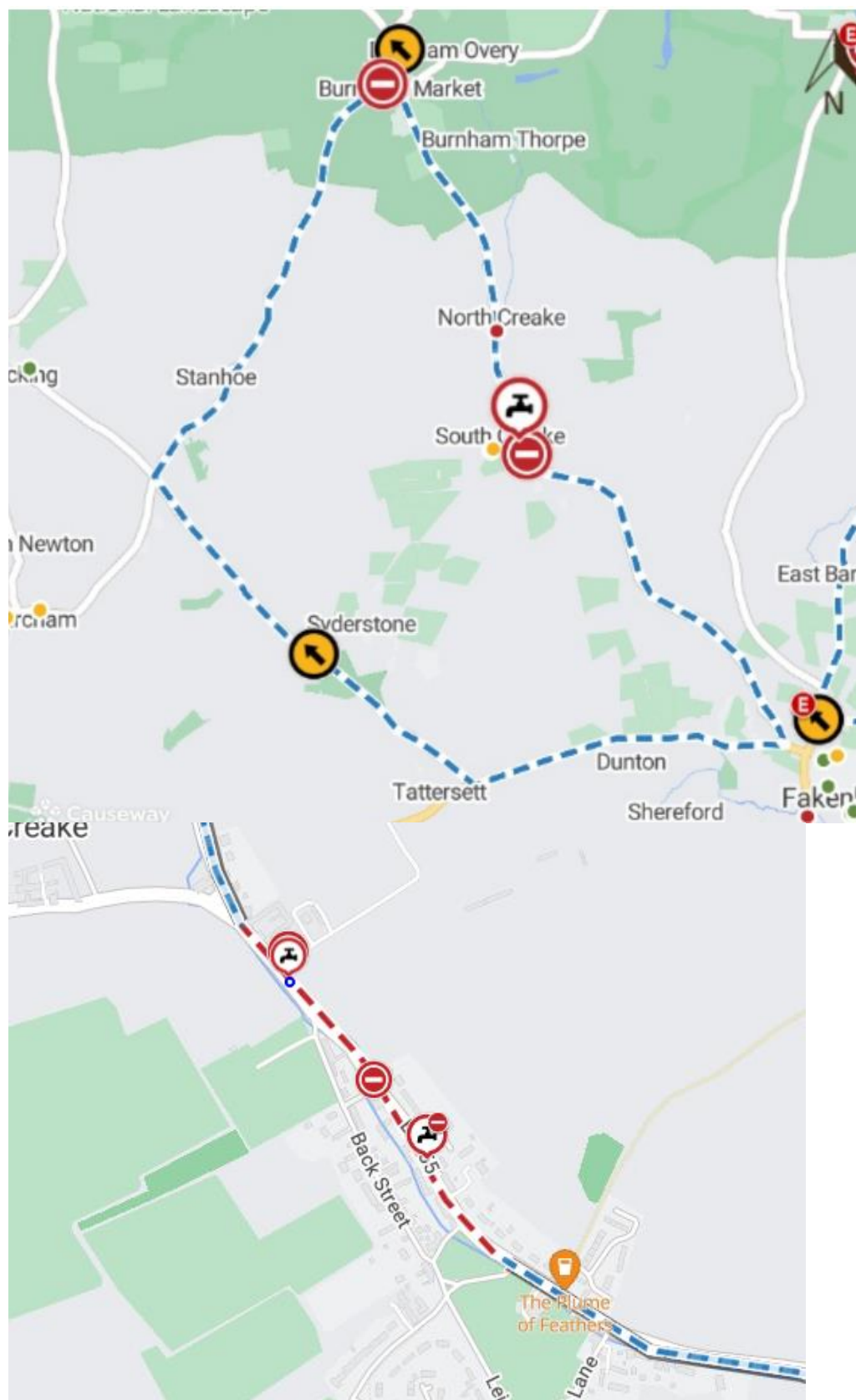
